

Yes, we are heading for autumn but I'm going to give you a great homemade burger recipe, it's not too late to get the bbq out again this year, I mean you probably haven't used it much since June. But now its September so go on do it. Now on our suffolkbugrs cook face-book page I did a couple of recipes for bbq meat, one for a spice rub chicken and the other a Chinese marinade pork steak, so try them out along with this homemade burger recipe. It's quick and easy..

This burger recipe makes either 4 x ¼ lb ish burgers or 3 chunky ones.

Ingredients

500g lean steak mince beef

- 1 large onion finely diced
- 2 cloves of garlic grated
- 1 tbsp smoked paprika
- 2 tbsp soy sauce
- 2 tbsp Worchester sauce

Salt

pepper

Method

Combine all the ingredients in a bowl add salt and pepper to your liking. Shape your burgers, fire up the bbq and cook them leaving them a little pink in the middle, if you like that way. Construct your fabulous burger with all the trimmings.


