

## You never know it could end up in our cook book 😂

This **Chinese style marinade** recipe came from a dish that we had on the Riverside Menu. When you make up the marinade, I would use half to marinade the meat and the other half to baste with or serve as a dribble of sauce.

The example here is with pork steaks, but obviously you can use whatever cut of meat you would like to do. There should be enough marinade here for 4 portions.

Mix all the ingredients together, pour some into a food bag with the meat in it and pack it into your cool box fridge ready for camping.

50ml Sherry 50ml soy sauce 100ml hoisin sauce 50ml tomato ketchup 50ml honey 50g freshly grated ginger A splash of vinegar 1 finely chopped chili (a chili of your choice bonnet, rocket, birds eye or just an English red chili) 3 cloves of garlic, crushed I served ours up with a mixed fried rice.
