
Spring / Summer 2025 Newsletter

We met at Walton meet which was a lovely day enjoyed the walk, the chips and the wet feet !




















Christmas Cruise



Suffolk Bugr's Cook

Jambalaya

The one-pot camp stove Jambalaya, this is probably one of the best dinners to do for the whole family or just the two of you whilst your away camping.

I keep a small selection of herbs and spices in our camper for all of our trips, and the one's used in this recipe would be in that selection.

There is no strict recipe for this dish, it was created in Louisiana from a blend of two different cultures then influenced by regional differences. Basically, you could take this recipe and alter it to suit your family tastes and preferences without feeling you've cheated on the origins of the dish (within reason!). So, give this a go this year.

Ingredients

1 tbsp paprika 6 boneless, skinless chicken thighs, cut into pieces ¹/₄ tsp cayenne pepper or chopped half red chili 100g chorizo, skinned and cut into chucks 1 tsp dried thyme 1 tbsp olive oil 1 tsp dried oregano 1 large onion, roughly chopped 2 bay leaves 4 celery sticks, chunky cut 450ml chicken stock 2 peppers, diced 100g cooked peeled king prawns Tin of chopped tomatoes 6 spring onions, sliced 200g Basmati rice flaked sea salt 3 garlic cloves, peeled and crushed freshly ground black pepper

Method

Heat the oil in a large non-stick frying pan or non-stick sauté pan and fry the chicken for 3 minutes over a medium heat until lightly coloured. Add the chorizo and cook for 30 seconds more, then cover with a lid and tip out excess oil, leave a little.

Return the pan to the heat and turn the heat down to low. Stir in the onion, celery and green peppers and cook for 8–10 minutes until well softened, stirring occasionally.

Stir the crushed garlic, paprika, cayenne, thyme, oregano and bay leaves into the frying pan and cook for 20–30 seconds, stirring. Increase the heat and add the chopped tomatoes.

Add the rice and cook for about a minute, stirring. Pour over the stock, season with a pinch of salt and lots of black pepper. Bring to a simmer and cook for about 10 minutes or until the rice is just tender and most of the liquid has evaporated or been absorbed by the rice, stirring occasionally. The rice should still be pretty saucy at this point, so if your rice takes longer to cook, you may need to add a little more stock.

Stir in the prawns and spring onions and cook for about 2 minutes more or until the prawns are hot, stirring regularly, then serve with some crusty baguette.
