Ye olde v dub cruiser – Isn't it great to have a vehicle on the road that is exempt from having to go through the process of MOT checks and those garage bills. Also to have your dub classed as 'historic tax class' so no yearly vehicle ££££ tax. That must put a smile on your face as you're driving down the road with your window down, waving to other V-Dubbers.

But let's just have a basic refresh on what the understanding is of being MOT exempt and road tax exempt. **MOT** - You do not need to get an MOT if:

- the vehicle was built or first registered more than 40 years ago
- no 'substantial changes' have been made to the vehicle in the last 30 years, for example replacing the chassis, body, axles or engine to change the way the vehicle works

**Tax** - If your vehicle was built before 1 January 1984, you can stop paying vehicle tax from 1 April 2024. There is loads more information on the government website which is worth a read, just to understand where you are at.

Now this is all great, but you are responsible to keep the vehicle road worthy, so unless you're a great mechanic / body & chassis repairer, it might be wise to get a 'MOT' done to be sure that you are safe on the road.

Most of us will have people / garages that we would recommend, but if you need a recommendation, please use the Suffolk Bugrs facebook page and ask. We also have a list of Members recommendations that we can send if requested. Lets keep these classics on the road.





#### **Blackberry Jam / Compote**

It's that time of year, where you might notice whilst you're camping or going on your local walks that the blackberries are coming through. Take the opportunity to pick some for a foodie delight. You only need a few and if you have children it's a great activity to get them involved.

#### **INGREDIANTS**

1 Mug of Blackberries 2<sup>nd</sup> Mug of Blackberries 2/3 of a mug of Sugar

#### **METHOD**

Place your pan on the heat and slowly melt down the sugar & 1 mug of blackberries, stir from time to time, it helps break up the blackberries.

Once the sugar is all melted, turn up the heat and boil the mix for about 10 min or until you see the jam mix thicken, add in the other mug of the blackberries and cook through for another 2 min. Turn off the heat and its ready to use however you like.

My example here is making thick pancakes, layered up with the compote jam and topped with Greek yogurt and homemade granola.

Enjoy your jam making.
